

Clinical Engineering Association of Illinois 2024 Scholarship Program

This \$1,000 scholarship is offered to promote awareness of and attract quality individuals to careers in the biomedical / clinical engineering technology profession. More graduates are needed to meet both current and long term employment requirements in this exciting growth field. The CEAI has typically awarded several scholarships each year.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled in or intending to enter a college or university as a full time student in a Biomedical Engineering Technology (BMET) program for at least six months of the school year beginning in of September 2024. Applicants may not be previous recipients of this scholarship award.
- 2. Applicants must demonstrate commitment to the biomedical / clinical engineering technology profession through submission of a 500-700 word essay.
- 3. Applicants must submit a copy of the most recent of one of the following: (1) high school transcript & diploma if graduated, GED certificate, or college transcript.
- 4. Applicants must complete and include the Application Form.
- 5. Finalists for the CEAI Scholarship will be required to interview with the Scholarship Committee who will determine the awardees.

Selection and Award Process:

- 1. Application Form, essay and academic transcripts are due by July 30, 2024.
- 2. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the CEAI, and finalists will be notified by August 15th, 2024 to schedule an interview with the Scholarship Committee. Awards are based primarily on the strength of the essay and interview.
- 3. Scholarship Awardees will be announced at the CEAI annual conference in October 2024.
- 4. Scholarship checks will be presented at the CEAI annual conference in October 2024.
- 5. The scholarship award may be paid directly to the college or university by the CEAI or directly to the awardee and requires proof of registration in a BMET program.
